The wine is pale straw in colour, with lifted lemony and vinous aromas, with a hint of nutty yeast character. The palate is very crisp and refreshing. Fresh lemon zest, some creaminess, and a zingy finish make this a delightful aperitif style.

Hand picked on 23rd January from our vineyard, the fruit was whole bunch pressed and only the first 500 litres per tonne juice extracted. The very low extraction rate resulted in a very fine clear juice with maximum freshness and little phenolics. The juice was tank fermented and tiraged on 2nd August. The first batch of this wine has recently been disgorged after ten months on lees. The wine was not liqueured during disgorging.
