2012 DWELLINGUP MOURVEDRE

Peel. Western Australia

Harvested from Orondo Farm and delivered to Faber

Bright purple red this wine has an intense aroma of blueberry ith comlexing earthy meaty notes. Te palate is initially delicious with a "hit" of sweet juicy fruit. The wine is soft and round with a light yet lengthy sweet fruited finish.

We have always called Mourvedre "poor man's shiraz" because it makes a sweet fruited soft wine. This is exactly what we have here. A delicious wine with quite intense flavour but light and savoury on the palate. Absolute beautiful with food, its soft tannins make it an ideal drink as a young wine.

"Boy this is a good wine to drink. A little pepper and dusty spice, blue and black berry fruits, purple florals, subtle nutty vanilla oak and some of that leather and dried herb aromatic that makes Mataro enthusiasts nostril hairs oscillate a little wildly. Medium bodied with soft, almost gummy feeling tannin, rounded acidity and a spicy blue fruited finish where the tannin cleans up beautifully. Great drinking. Can't recommend it highly enough."
