2013 Dwellingup Mourvedre

Peel region, Western Australia

Fruit from a small block of Mourvedre planted in 2008 at Orondo Farm in Dwellingup. Fermented on skins in open fermenters with careful maceration in old barrels.

Our aim is to make a savoury, fruit forward style with an element of earthiness, spicy and savouriness. A medium bodied style with attractive drying finish.

“For the synaesthetes among us, this is a very purple smelling wine. Blue and red fruit – floral and peppery – banana split vanilla of older oak, some dried herb. Medium bodied, quite fresh and tangy – acidity pretty sharp and bitey here – silty open weave tannin, decent finish. Needs a bit of time, maybe. ”
