2014 Dwellingup Mourvedre

Peel region, Western Australia

Mourvedre vines are very distinctive in the vineyard with their very upright growth habit. The bunches are medium in size, quite tight and the berries round and dark. Vines look absolutely perfect for growing healthy, flavoursome fruit.

Medium red in colour. The nose displays lifted black cherry fruit, attractive dusty oak and hints of leather.

A soft round palate of red fruits and earthy flavours. Beautifully integrated oak and fruit flavours, complex and savoury with fine tannins and hints of spice.

“Banana split, pot pourri, dusty spices, dried mint and plums. Medium bodied, a little arthy and savoury with silty tannins, mixed berries, a sprinkle of dried herbs and Mataro’s muscular flex of tannin on the finish. Almost a gummy feel here, which is most enjoyable, as is the wine itself.”
