FABER VINEYARD DWELLINGUP CHARDONNAY 2005

Light straw-green; crisp and elegant, with excellent length to the nectarine, melon and citrus fruit; the oak well-balanced and integrated.

FABER VINEYARD RICHE SHIRAZ 2005

Generous, ripe blackberry and plum fruit; restrained alcohol and oak; overall, medium-bodied and well-balanced.

FABER VINEYARD PETIT VERDOT 2005

Strong purple-red; much more red fruit tones than is normally the case, also more to medium-bodied than full-bodied; all these are better things.

FABER VINEYARD RESERVE SHIRAZ 2004

Very good colour; a skillfully structured wine, with very attractive black and red fruits; silky, smooth tannins and a whisk of quality oak.

Light to medium-bodied; sweet cherry, plum and blackberry; controlled extract, though not especially complex.
