FABER VINEYARD DWELLINGUP CHARDONNAY 2006

A fine and fragrant bouquet; a beautifully restrained palate, with melon and nectarine fruit; whole-bunch pressed, barrelfermented and 10 months on lees, but still towards Chablis in style.

FABER VINEYARD RICHE SHIRAZ 2006

The unusually cool vintage has partially tamed the usual Alaskan bear style; blackberry fruits, with quality French and American oak.

Winemaker John Griffiths has used a gentle approach to the variety, backed up by the cool vintage; the result is a positively elegant wine, almost too much so for the variety.
