FABER VINEYARD DWELLINGUP CHARDONNAY 2008

A finely crafted, elegant and, if anything, understated chardonnay which has absorbed barrel ferment and 10 months in oak with nonchalant ease; gentle stone fruit, melon and creamy nuances run the length of the palate.

FABER VINEYARD RICHE SHIRAZ 2008

Strong crimson-purple; supple, black fruits on the generously endowed, medium-bodied palate, the tannins fine and the oak well-integrated. High quality cork.

FABER VINEYARD PETIT VERDOT 2008

The hue is good, although more diffuse than the best examples of Faber, but the upside is a more open and accessible medium-bodied palate, the tannins not aggressive.

FABER VINEYARD SHIRAZ CABERNET 2008

An attractive medium-bodied palate, with a mix of blackberry, blackcurrant and cherry, the tannins fine, the oak subtle. Easy style, best young.

FABER VINEYARD DWELLINGUP MALBEC 2007

Bright crimson; fresh and spicy aromas and flavours, with none of the jammy fruit often associated with malbec, nor the lack of mid-palate structure; has bright red fruit flavours and very good length.

FABER VINEYARD FRANKLAND RIVER CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2007

Purple-crimson; strong blackcurrant aromas lead into a full-bodied palate with similar fruit joined by French oak and very robust tannins; demands cellaring despite a dodgy wine-streaked cork.

FABER VINEYARD RESERVE SHIRAZ 2006

Attractive medium-bodied wine, with distinct fruit sweetness and some contrasting spicy/savoury notes; good tannins and oak.
