2 Faber Vineyard Reserve shiraz 2011 (\$58)

An awesome statement of old-vine Swan Valley shiraz, with John Griffiths' meticulous attention to detail. Beautiful deep red and magenta. The aroma of violets and cherry plum is so engaging, with its little sprinkle of spices. A slightly minerally thread and fine-grained vanillin oak contribute to a stunning palate design and delivery. And this wine is made right on our doorstep. 95/100 (Best drinking: 2016-29 Alc: 14%)
