

## Faber Vineyard Dwellingup chardonnay 2013 (\$28)

Finely-balanced and quite delicate wine sourced from fruit in the south at Dwellingup. Has a light creamy texture and subtle stone fruit with a distinctive nutty brioche influence. It has been barrel fermented and then spent eight months in older oak so the influence is more subtle and the wine all the better for it.

## Faber Vineyard Frankland River cabernet sauvignon 2012 (\$42)

Such dense opaque colour. This is made from fruit sourced from Frankland River. It is hugely concentrated and powerful from the intensity on the nose through to the awesome power and persistence of the palate. Rich sametal cabernet with dominant blackcurrant and dark prommy chocolate characters. Plenty of oak has been wound into it and the result is a superb wine.

## Faber Vineyard Reserve shiraz 2011 (\$58)

An awesome statement of old vine Swan Valley shiraz made with Griffiths' meticulous attention to detail. Beautiful colour of deep red and magenta. The aroma of violets and cherry plum is so engaging with its little sonkle of spices. It has a sumptuous palate with such power, yet such grace and elegance. A slightly minerally mread and fine grained vanillin oak contribute to a sunning palate design and delivery.

## Faber Vineyard Riche shiraz 2013 (\$25)

Drawn from fruit grown on a number of Swan Valley meyards. It is a soft and generous wine with a juicy ripe bery character evident immediately. The palate is supple meat tannin and oak in support. A fruit-driven style much is drinking beautifully now as a youngster.
