Rigid lines of tannin keep rolls of licorice, coffee grounds and asphalt-like flavour in trim, taut shape. It's no mean feat. Creamy oak hovers without ever getting in the way. The longer you sit with this wine the grander it seems. 14.5% alc.

You need a 'squirrel mentality'. Put aside a few dozen of your favourite wines from good vintages for five or six years and you have the basis of a good cellar.


What makes a wine cellar-worthy?
