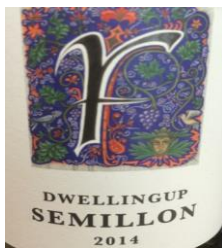
Dusty spice box, sweet cherry, some new leather and savoury flavours. Light to medium bodied, fresh and slightly creamy, definitely not a confectioned style, falling more to savoury and earthy. Tannin is very firm and almost ropey. Length is good, with tannin chomping on the finish. Great to see a Grenache with a bit of structure.

Excellent drinking. Would be great with some sort of slow cooked meat, or cassoulet.
